

COVID-19 Vaccines for Children Age 5 to 11

Pfizer's COVID-19 vaccine for children age 5 to 11 has been authorized for use and is now available in Rhode Island.

Children age 5 to 11 can get the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine in different places:



School-based vaccination clinics
